

One integrity bar is not enough.

SaniTap credits pass six independent bars, each defending the credit against a different type of buyer challenge. No single layer is unassailable. The sum is materially harder to unwind than any part.

05 · Article 6 Letter of Approbation

Formal host-country authorisation from the Government of Madagascar for international transfer.

04 · Third-party sensor monitoring

Independent hardware verification on a randomised sample. Beyond what Gold Standard requires.

03 · ICVCM Core Carbon Principles alignment

Third-party programme-level assessment against the 10 CCPs.

02 · Gender-responsive certification

Gold Standard's higher-tier optional certification. Proactive gender analysis, not just do-no-harm.

01 · Gold Standard for Global Goals

The foundation. Registered methodology (TPDDTEC v4.0 / ERSOWS v1.0), verification cycle, public registry paper trail.

The one-line hostile-audit test

An integrity-stacked credit is a credit that would defend well in a hostile due-diligence session across six independent dimensions, not just one. That is what SaniTap develops.
